Dear Parent

It is hard to believe that we are approaching the end of this school year which has been like no other! As normal the teachers have prepared an annual report for your child which outlines their achievements, strengths and areas for development. This report can be collected from school on **Monday 29 June** at the following times:

- 9.00am – 11.00am Year 1 – 3 pupils
- 11.00am – 1.00pm Year 4 – 7 pupils

If you have more than one child attending our school, please collect all reports at the one time rather than having to return twice. Along with your child's report will be their school books, PE kits and any other belongings which remain in school. We would also ask you to bring any school books e.g. Reading books, library books etc. in with you and leave them in your child's classroom.

It is essential that all parents access the classrooms via the outside/playground doors as this will facilitate the required social distancing. No parents should use the main entrance. Teachers will be present in their classrooms at these times to help you locate reports and belongings.

We have also included a letter detailing your child's next teacher and a copy of the school holidays, although these may require alteration due to the changing nature of the situation we find ourselves in. As you can imagine plans for re-opening remain fluid, however it is finally a relief to have received some guidance from DE regarding this.

While things may change between now and then it is our intention to re-open in September to as many pupils as possible, hopefully this will be to all pupils. All Year 7 pupils will attend school on Monday 24 August while the remainder of our pupils will begin on Tuesday 1 September.
